End of Year Reminders

It is hard to believe we are at the end of the school year. There are a few things that need to be taken care of before we finish the year.

- ✓ Library Notices: No books may be checked out after May 11th. All books must be returned by May 18th. Any lost books will need to be paid for by the last day of school or report cards will be held at the office.
- ✓ Lunch News: If you have any outstanding balances they must be paid by May 1st.
- ✓ Your child will receive a cheese sandwich if there is an unpaid balance.
- ✓ From the Office: If you will not be here the last day of school, you will need to leave a large, self-addressed stamped envelope in the office so the report card can be mailed. You may pick it up at the office the next week if you don't want it mailed. If you have medication left at school, you need to pick it up before the end of the year. All 5th graders, if you are planning to participate in Middle School activities you must have a physical.
- ✓ If you will be changing schools, have a new address, and/or a new phone number, please let the office know. You can call 281-6204 or send a note letting us know of any changes.

Kindergarten Registration

We have started our kindergarten registration for the 2018-2019 school year. All registration forms will be dated when they are completed & turned in. This will be for priority placement. Please tell your neighbors and other Big Sky families about registering kindergarten children starting now.

To register for kindergarten, your child must be 5 years old by Sept. 10th. When you register, you need to bring in a birth certificate and current immunization record. You can register without the final shots, but we need proof of the shots before the child can attend school. The enrollment form can be picked up at the school or you may go on the Billings Public Schools web site and print off a form. Fill out the form and bring it into the school. The completed form, birth certificate, and proof of immunizations must be returned to the school before June 1st. The school office isn't open during the summer. Getting the registrations during the spring allows us to prepare for adequate staffing. In mid August, you will receive a letter informing you of your child's teacher and additional information pertaining to school.

This year we are trialing an online appointment and payment system. Starting April 2nd, you will be able to register your student and pay in advance at billingsclinic.com/sportsphysicals.

Students will be seen on a continuous basis from 3:30-4:30 but arriving at your appointment time with payment complete will greatly decrease your total time spent in process.

It would be much appreciated if these dates, times could be placed in the high schools, middle schools and elementary schools' newsletter.

Parents need to be informed that if there is family history of premature sudden death under age 40, a personal history of fainting, passing out, chest discomfort/shortness of breath with exercise and/or any complex medical condition with ongoing treatment, we will not be able to clear them with this sports physical. We suggest that these students followup with their family physician or pediatrician.

Safety Helmet Info

We just wanted to share this information with you all so that we are consistent. We know it is super hard to monitor, but if you have a kiddo who needs a helmet (especially if they are riding a wheeled vehicle to school), please let Mrs. Reas know and she will get them one right away. Here is a link to some info. on our city's code for kids under 16 and helmets. https://helmets.org/billings.htm

Section 2. That the Billings, Montana City Code be amended by adding Section 24-605 to read as follows:

Sec. 24-605. Protective Bicycle Helmets Shall Be Worn.

(a) All individuals under sixteen (16) years of age while operating a bicycle upon any way in the city limits must wear a protective bicycle helmet of good fit which is securely fastened to the operator's head.
