Where do I go if my child is over five, is enrolled in public school or I intend to enroll them in Public School?

If your child is currently enrolled in public school and is age 5, or older contact your school representative, teacher or principal to request a screening.

### Where do I go if my child is enrolled in a Private School in Billings?

If your child is currently enrolled in Private School within Billings Public School Boundaries and is age 5 or older, contact your school representative, teacher or principal to request a screening. Your school representative will contact BPS for any assistance needed.
