Inclement Weather Tips and Practices

RECESS: OUT OR IN?

We will go <u>outside</u> for recess if

 the temperature with wind chill is zero or above

or

2. it is raining lightly, and students will not get wet through their clothing.

We will stay **inside**for recess if

the temperature
with wind chill
drops below zero

or

2. it is raining hard enough that students will get wet through their clothing.

Dress your child appropriately for rain, cold and snow!

Please make sure your child has appropriate clothing for inclement weather on or with them. Do not assume that students will be inside whether cold, snowing or raining — Montana weather changes quickly, so it is best to be prepared for cold, rainy, or snowy weather.

Appropriate <u>COLD</u> and <u>SNOWY</u> weather clothing consists of: a winter coat, hat or hood, gloves or mittens, snow boots, long pants, and snow pants if your child has them. <u>Students without snow boots and snow pants will not be allowed on the snow during recess.</u> If your child is in need of any of these items, please contact the office.

Appropriate clothing for <u>RAINY</u> weather is a water-resistant jacket with a hood and/or an umbrella.
