Goals

- 4. Strengthening and improving relations and interactions among staff, trustees, citizens, parents, and students.
- 5. Promoting understanding and cooperation between the schools and community groups, including neighborhoods; religious, fraternal, and service organizations; labor, business, and industrial units; councils and political organizations; recreational organizations; and other governmental agencies.
- 6. Cooperating with the news media to more effectively inform the community about the District and about educational matters in general.
